Less than 20% of the energy in Smart Complete is derived from starch sources. The balance of the energy in Smart Complete is provided in the form of fat and fiber. This energy partitioning makes Smart Complete an excellent choice for mature horses needing a quiet source of energy.

Smart Complete contains high levels of beet pulp, considered to be a "super fiber" for horses. Beet pulp is one of the three most digestible fiber sources for horses and is typically found to be the most palatable. By providing such a high level of digestible fiber, Smart Complete makes an excellent choice for horses with limited access to high quality hay and/ or pasture. This is essentially vital to horses with elevated exercise requirements, as the digestible fiber will assist in the maintenance of a healthy digestive system. Research has proven that diets high in fat and fiber reduce the incidence of performance limiting problems such as gastric ulcers and tying-up.

Ingredients: Whole oats, beet pulp, soybean hulls, molasses products, vegetable oil, wheat middlings, dehydrated alfalfa meal, soybean meal, ground oats, maize distillers dried grains with soluble dehydrated, dicalcium phosphate, calcium carbonate, salt, yeast cultures, magnesium oxide, magnesium citrate, magnesium hydroxide, magnesium sulfate, vitamin A supplement, vitamin D3 supplement, vitamin E supplement, vitamin B12 supplement, menadione sodium bisulfite complex, riboflavin supplement, d-calcium pantothenate, thiamine mononitrate, niacin supplement, pyridoxine hydrochloride, folic acid, choline chloride, biotin, zinc sulfate, ferrous sulfate, manganese sulfate, copper sulfate, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, cobalt sulfate, sodium selenite, copper proteinate, zinc proteinate, manganese proteinate, natural and artificial flavors.
