8550 =

- **New Workhorse wheat**
- Great head scab resistance
- Awesome straw (High Quality) Bright Color after dry down
- Superstar yield potential
- Performs well in low to moderate yield environments
- Bearded
- State of the art Fusarium Head Blight resistance
- Excellent Test Weight
- Full Season - Tall and stands well

8340 =

- **Old workhorse to be replaced by 8550**
- Top seller the last 3 years
- Bearded
- Resists most common diseases
- Strong tillering
- Good straw (Medium height)

9606 =

- **New Racehorse wheat**
- Extremely high yield potential
- Must push overall nutrition, especially Nitrogen
- Also must keep healthy with in season fungicide application
- Although a little disease prone, the overall disease package is better than the old 9415
- Bearded
- Above average tolerance to Fusarium Head Blight
- Good straw strength
- Mid Maturing
- Long Head
- Grain stays in head late
- No Real Weaknesses

9415 =

- Old Racehorse wheat to be replaced by 9606
- Bearded
- Good test weight
- High maintenance (Needs fungicide)
- One of the highest yielders in the lineup
- Must push it with nutrition especially Nitrogen
- Later maturing
- Lots of tillers

8415 =

- Hay/Forage Wheat
- Awnless
- Early
- Resistance to fly pressure
- Fungicide recommended
- Responds well to population
